Tension

It is essential to work to the stated tension in order to achieve the desired fabric and garment size. You should always start by knitting a tension square before knitting the full garment.

If you have fewer stitches than stated you will need to go down needle sizes until the correct tension is achieved. If you have more you will need to go up needle sizes. Please check individual patterns for tension before starting the garment.

Finishing

We recommend using mattress stitch for seaming your garment. When sewing in a raglan sleeve you will match row for row. When sewing in a semi set-in sleeve you will need to fold the sleeve in half, and matching the fold to the shoulder seam, sew in position easing into the armhole.

Once your garment is completed it is essential to block your knitting. Pin your garment out to the size stated in the pattern. Cover with a damp cloth and leave to dry.



Scarf

Width 25cm x length 172cm (approximately)

Hat

Tension

27 sts and 44 rows to 10cm measured over reverse slip stitch rib pattern when slightly stretched using 4mm needles or size needed to achieve stated tension. It is essential to work to the stated tension to ensure success.

Equipment

Scarf

One pair 4mm (UK 8/US 6) knitting needles.

One pair 3.25mm (UK 10/US 3) knitting needles. One pair 4mm (UK 8/US 6) knitting needles. Two stitch markers.

Hat

Using 4mm needles cast on 127 [135] sts.

Row 1 (RS): * K3, yf, sl1p, yb, rep from * to last 3 sts, K3.

Row 2: K1, * yf, sl1p, yb, K3, rep from * to last 2 sts, yf, sl1, yb, K1.

These 2 rows set reverse slip stitch rib.

Work in rib for 5cm, ending with **RS** facing for next row.

Place markers at each end of last row.

Cont in rib until work measures 23 [24]cm from cast on edge, ending with **RS** facing for next row.

Shape Crown

Row 1 (RS): (K1, sl1, K1, psso, yf, sl1p, yb, K3, yf, sl1p, yb) 15 [16] times, K1, sl1, K1, psso, yf, sl1p, yb, K3. 111 [118] sts.

Row 2: K1, (yf, sl1p, yb, K2, yf, sl1p, yb, K3) 15 [16] times, yf, sl1p, yb, K2, yf, sl1p, yb, K1.

Row 3: (K1, sl1, K1, psso, K3, yf, sl1p, yb) 15 [16] times, K1, sl1, K1, psso, K3. 95 [101] sts.

Row 4: K1, (yf, sl1p, yb, K1, yf, sl1p, yb, K3) 15 [16] times, yf, sl1p, yb, K1, yf, sl1p, yb, K1.

Row 5: (K1, sl1, K1, psso, K2, yf, sl1p, yb) 15 [16] times, K1, sl1, K1, psso, K2. 79 [84] sts.

Row 6: K1, (yf, sl2p, yb, K3) 15 [16] times, yf, sl2p, yb, K1.

Row 7: (K1, sl1, K1, psso, K1, yf, sl1p, yb) 15 [16] times, K1, sl1, K1, psso, K1. 63 [67] sts.

Row 8: K1, (yf, sl1p, yb, K3) 15 [16] times, yf, sl1p, yb, K1.

Row 9: (K1, sl1, K1, psso, yf, sl1p, yb) 15 [16] times, K1, sl1, K1, psso. 47 [50] sts.

Row 10: (Yf, sl1p, yb, K2) 15 [16] times, yf, sl1p, yb, K1.

Row 11: (K1, sl1, K1, psso) 15 [16] times, K2. 32 [34] sts.

Row 12: K1, (P2tog) 15 [16] times, K1. 17 [18] sts.

Break off yarn and thread through rem sts, pull up tight and fasten off.

Making Up

Join side seam reversing first 5cm to markers for turn back. Pin your garment out to the size stated in the pattern, cover with a damp cloth and leave to dry.

Scarf

Using 4mm needles cast on 67 sts.

Row 1 (RS): * K3, yf, sl1p, yb, rep from * to last 3 sts, K3.

Row 2: K1, * yf, sl1p, yb, K3, rep from * to last 2 sts, yf, sl1p, yb, K1.

These 2 rows set reverse slip stitch rib.


Work in rib to end of 3rd ball leaving enough yarn for casting off, ending with **WS** facing for next row.

Cast off in patt.

Making Up

Pin your garment out to the size stated in the pattern, cover with a damp cloth and leave to dry.
